The Religious Studies Program is now accepting applications for the **Rombach and Bretall Scholarships** for the academic year 2014-2015.

The application **deadline is November 21, 2014.** Scholarship applications should be submitted to the front desk in Learning Services Building 203. If you received a Rombach or Bretall scholarship in the past we would remind you that it is non-renewable and you are not eligible for another scholarship. One scholarship per person.

Awards will be made based on academic achievement, need, and seniority in the program (the number of RELI courses taken for the major).

- Applicants must be Religious Studies majors in good standing
- Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA
